HOW DOES USING A CELEBRANT WORK?

We can light candles or put rose petals in the casket or hand out memory cards for each person to fill out, what ever the family wants. The Celebrant can help you with ideas that will fit the deceased and the family..

On the day of the tribute, the Celebrant will officiate and oversee the celebration.
